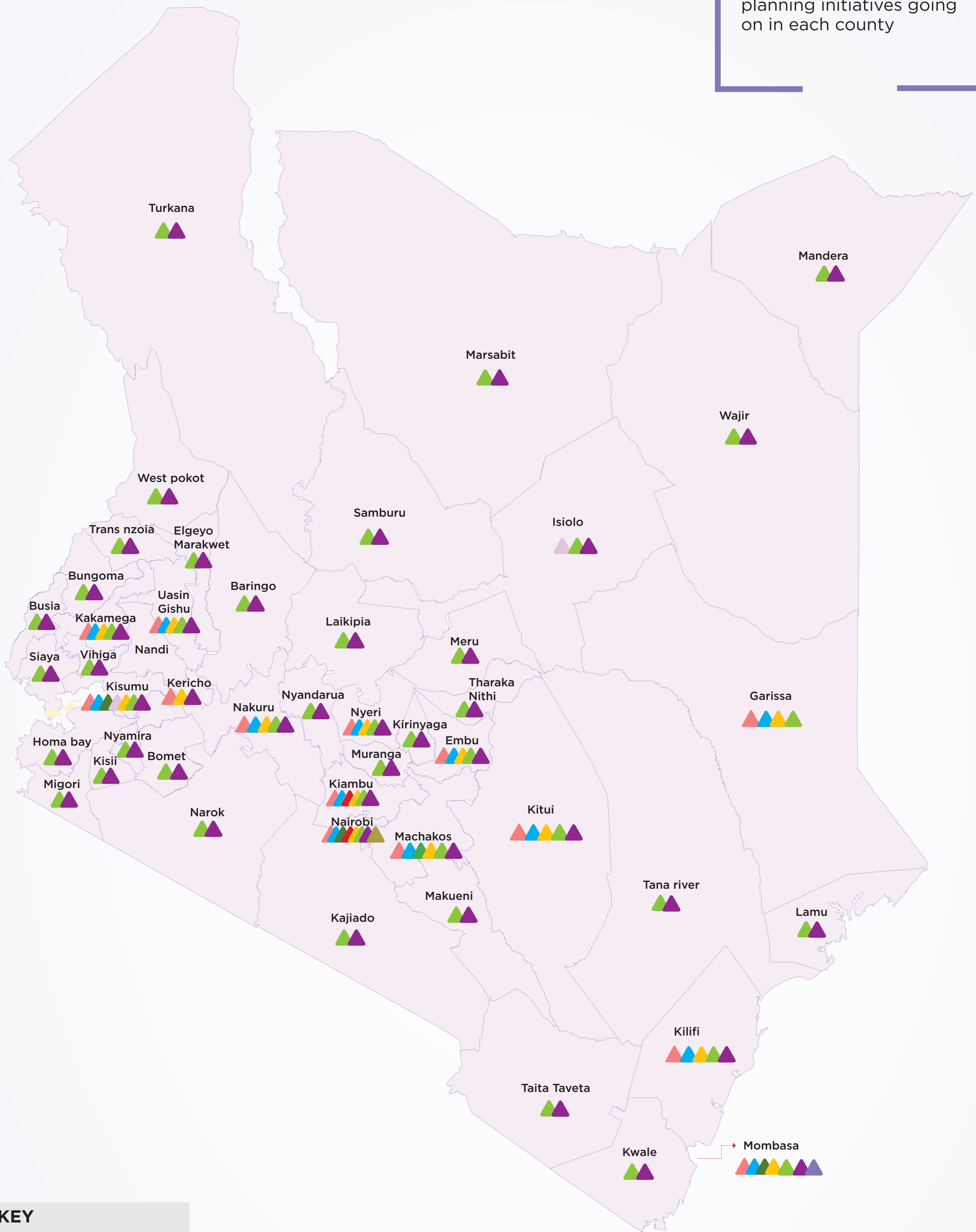


Urban Planning Initiatives

This map shows various planning initiatives going on in each county



KEY

- Kenya Informal Settlements Improvement Project (KISIP)**
 Aimed at improving living conditions in informal settlements in selected towns in Kenya by strengthening institutions and programme management, enhancing tenure security, investing in infrastructure and service delivery and planning for urban growth
- Kenya Municipal Programme (KMP)**
 To strengthen local governance and improve service delivery in selected municipalities
- Kenya Slum Upgrading Programme (KENSUP)**
 Aimed at improving the livelihoods of people living and working in slums and informal settlement in the urban areas of Kenya through the provision of security of tenure and physical and social infrastructure as well as providing opportunities for housing improvement and income generation
- Urban Collaboration and Planning Workshop for Stakeholders**
 Aimed at creating awareness of collaboration benefits among stakeholders involved in the *Global Programme for Public Space* project and the *Kenya Municipal Programme*
- Establishing Effective, Participatory & Accountable Governance At County Level**
 Aimed at capacity building of the civil society and local authorities, public mobilization for participation; and effective non-sector actors participation in County planning
- Nairobi Integrated Urban Development Master Plan (NIUPLAN)**
 The Master Plan integrates all the existing Master Plans of various infrastructure within the city of Nairobi and its surrounding. Infrastructure includes urban transport, railway, airport, power and water supply, sewerage, telecommunication and solid waste management.
- Mombasa Master Plan**
 Mombasa is preparing a master plan for the town to help address climate change problems and disaster related issues.
- County Executives in charge of Urban Planning**
 A department responsible for urban planning established within the 10 executive positions. Activities within the docket include rating and valuation, property management, forward planning, development control, urban design, land survey, enforcement of policies, rental housing development & management, low cost housing, slum upgrading, and urban environment control among others
- County Integrated Development Plans (CIDPs)**
 The County Government's Act, 2012 (CGA), 104 obligates a county to develop among other county plans, a County Integrated Development Plan (CIDP). This is a 5-year plan that shall inform the county's annual budget. It shall reflect the strategic mid-term priorities of the county governments
- Local Urban Forums (LUFs)**
 A platform that brings together over 900 Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), County Officials and Private sector actors to promote knowledge based dialogue on the evolving urban landscape in Kenya
