
CISUMU DUICK WIN PROJECT

This so called quick win project will build the capacity of local residents on waste management. It focuses on encouraging recycling, and using waste for entrepreneurial purposes.

Willing residents together with children in both primary and secondary schools in the locality will be trained as champions, and tasked with spreading the message of good waste management practices. The existing drainage system in Ahero will be cleaned by local youth, engaged by the County of Kisumu. Furthermore, a new drainage system will be dug up to complete the drainage cycle.

The aim of all this is to have a clean and pleasant Ahero, while reducing sanitation-related diseases among residents, and also creating employment opportunities for the youth.
